

Dear all

One member of our congregation last Sunday has subsequently tested positive to COVID. Test and Trace has since identified people who need to self-isolate, including myself. In light of this, the PCC and I have taken the decision to have an online service only this coming Sunday (30<sup>th</sup> May). You can be assured that we have followed all the current guidelines for a COVID-safe environment in the church. The church will remain open for private prayer on Wednesday and Saturday.

If anyone has any concerns, please contact me. The Government advises that everyone should be vaccinated when they are invited, and has recently recommended everyone should self-test twice a week. Test kits are available for free at local pharmacies.
